



# THE WAKEFIELD VARIATION

The Wakefield Variation is a webseries created and produced by Effetto Espanso, video production studio founded in 2009 in Pisa, Italy. The story is loosely based on "Wakefield", a short story by Nathaniel Hawthorne, now set in the present time. The story follows the apparently simple plot of Hawthorne's Wakefield: some day a young man decides to leave the girlfriend he lived with, and vanishes. Our man has been hiding in a small apartment for years: he didn't leave any traces behind, and keeps spying on his former girlfriend using bugs and hidden cameras, in a sort of twisted social experiment. Time goes by, in a flow of memories, thoughts, and loneliness. When the girl - who has long moved on - is about to make a step which would put her out of range for good, Wakefield



starts thinking about getting back into her life. The series, an independent production shot in Italy with an international cast, can be watched on many digital platforms, starting from the official site www.thewakefieldvariation.com, source of the most updated information.

One look behind is a prequel, telling a story from the main character's teenage years, exposing details still hidden in the series.



#### Effetto Espanso

It's the studio behind the project. Founded in Pisa by Gianluca Olmastroni (1981) and Alessandro De Nicola (1983), it deals with film and video, their convergence and generally about motion picture storytelling. It was started by two former film studies students of Pisa University: its goals are the merging of academic background and field work, while it looks forward to technological, stylistic and creative trends. Halfway between being a service company and a production studio, it originally focused on documentary before moving to fiction: before The Wakefield Variation it has produced tourist (Treasures of Genoa) and creative (The Sound of Revolution) documentaries. ## IS WAKEFIELD A PRISONER IN AMSTERDAM?

New lead in hunt for missing IT consultant

May 9, 2005

A retired private detective is convinced he spotted him in the Dutch city two weeks ago, providing a vital new lead.

The 28-year-old has not been seen since he vanished from his girlfriend's house last year.

The reported sighting has left Roger Wakefield's anguished family and friends desperately hoping this is the breakthrough they need — but worried about what it could mean.

His girlfriend Eleanor Cooper, 24: "Roger didn't tell me much about his work, but as far as I know didn't even know anyone from Holland, he never expressed any interest in going there.

"If Roger is in Amsterdam, he's there because he's been taken against his will. He was never interested in drugs — he was anti-drugs — so that's not why he would be there.

"He would not go there of his own choice. He must have been taken there and now not be able to get back."

Roger's dad Peter, 60, a retired policeman, added: "He has never been to Amsterdam and I can't understand how, if it was him, he was being allowed to wander the streets."

# BODY IN WOODS BELIEVED TO BE MISSING MAN FROM 5 -YEAR OLD COLD CASE

CLARKSBURG, Md. – Police found remains Tuesday morning that they believe are those of a missing 31- year-old man who disappeared in 2003. Rover Wakefield, IT consultant, was last self by his girlfriend on the Papyrus Lakeshore.

Inv stigators discovered the remains of a caucasian man about 9 a.m. in a wooded area of Montgomery County, Md., after a search that covered 30,000 acres. Montgomery County Police Chief J. William Reyes said officers believe the body is that of Roger Wakefield. The body was found about 50 yards off Maryland Route 121 by a police canine unit.

Authorities began searching for the man after an anonymous information. To complete identification, dna test results are due next week, but body measurements corresponds and former girlfriend Eleanor Cooper was reported being positive about clothes. The autopsy revealed multiple chest wounds as cause of death. Reyes said police believe Roger Wakefield's body has been at the site off Route 121 since last month.

"This is not the ending we were hoping for," said Capt. Bruce Spender, a police spokesman. "Everyone involved in this held on to a shred of hope that we would find Wakefield alive." LYNN, Ma. – Eleanor Cooper, girlfriend of missing man Roger Wakefield, reads a statement at the press conference.

Lakeshore in january 2003 has made a tearful appeal for information about him. His girlfriend, Eleanor Cooper, 25, told a press conference: "I just want to say how worried we are about Roger. Someone out there must know where he is, as we still believe he's alive."

"This is a terrible time for all of us and we are hoping for hissafe return." Chief Inspector Bruce Spender, of Greater

Boston police, said: "For Wakefield not to return home after a night out and not make any contact with friends or family is not only unusual for him, but is something that he has never done before.

"Roger Wakefield doesn't appear to have

any reason in his personal life that would indicate that he might want to leave the area."

"Roger's family are extremely worried about him and we are offering them our full support." Papyrus Lake, where police have focused their search, didn't give out any body or sign of it. Spender urged anyone with information to come forward and made a direct appeal to Wakefield. He said: "It is very important that anyone who knows of Roger's whereabouts or of any reason for him to stay away contacts we

### YOUNG MAN DISAPPEARS

Roger Wakefield, 26, was last seen on January 12th

LYNN, Ma. - Police are searching for a 26-year-old man who allegedly vanished after leaving the lakeshore of Papyrus Lake, this saturday.

The 26-year-old man, Roger Wakefield, was reportedly last seen by his girlfriend Eleanor, shortly before 10 am, as they met for a walk. The girl said they were having relationship problems. A press release issued by the police describes him as "white, of medium build, with short brown hair and a stubble" and says that "he was last seen wearing a dark leather jacket, light blue shirt, maroon trousers and green wellington boots."

The Herald quotes an officer as saying, "Roger's family are clearly very worried about him and are desperate for any information relating to his whereabouts. We would urge anyone who may have seen him to contact the police. Roger, if you see or hear this appeal, we would ask that you make contact with us or the police as soon as possible." According to the report, anyone with information should call the Greater Boston Police at 555 856 7652.
